This corpus categorizes gaming terminology used in MMORPGs into four main groups:

- 1. **Acronymic Contractions (AC)** Abbreviations and shorthand commonly used in MMO communication.
- 2. **Modified Meanings (MM)** Standard English words that have developed specialized meanings in gaming.
- 3. **Newbies (Ne)** Terms used to describe or relate to new players.
- 4. **Simple Contractions (SC)** Shortened words or phrases used for efficiency in communication.
